

Houghton County Land Bank Authority 2014 Annual Report

Board of Directors: Kathleen Beattie, Chairperson; John Haeussler, Secretary; James Hainault, Treasurer; Glenn Anderson; William Hodges.

The Houghton County Land Bank Authority (LBA) Board of Directors met four times in 2014: June 9; August 9; September 2; and, October 20.

The board welcomed new member Glenn Anderson and thanked outgoing member Dennis Barrette for his service. Director Anderson is the Hancock City Manager and serves as the board's local government official. Directors Anderson and Hainault were appointed by the county commissioners to three-year terms expiring December 31, 2016. The board elected officers including Director Haeussler as secretary and Director Hainault as treasurer.

Entering 2014 the LBA had three properties in its inventory. The LBA sold 1219 12th Street, Lake Linden (table 1, property 1) for \$1,000.00 plus applicable deed recording fee(s) via the side lot disposition program. Offers were solicited, but none received, via the side lot disposition program for a 0.1 acre lot in Sidnaw (table 2, property 3). The parcel is of limited utility and remains available for sale from the LBA. Due to adjacent properties entering the tax foreclosure system offering the potential to pool the properties in the future, the LBA took no action on 439 Pine Street, Calumet (table 2, property 7).

The county treasurer foreclosed thirty-one (31) properties in 2014. The board discussed all of the taxforeclosed properties and the vast majority of them were visited by two or more board members for visual inspection.

Following the second and final public tax sale auction twelve (12) unsold properties were rejected by their local units of government and subsequently were conveyed to the LBA by the Houghton County Treasurer. (See table 1, properties 2-13.)

The LBA also purchased two (2) properties in Houghton County from the State of Michigan Land Bank Fast Track Authority for a total of \$100.00 plus a \$35.00 processing fee. (See table 1, properties 14-15.)

At the close of 2014 the LBA had sixteen (16) properties in its inventory. (See table 2.)
